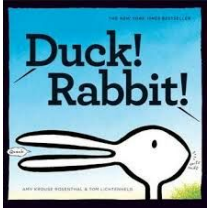
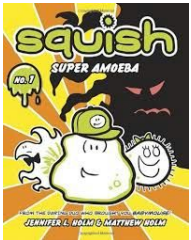


### ***Duck! Rabbit!***

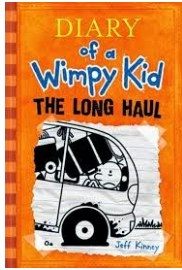

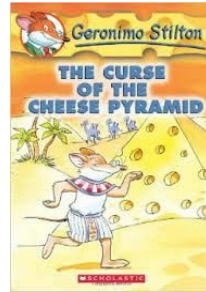

***The Curse of the Cheese Pyramid***

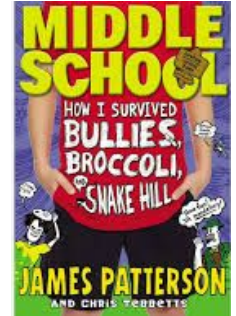
