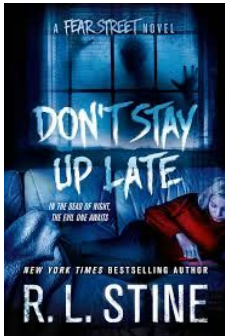

by Candace Fleming

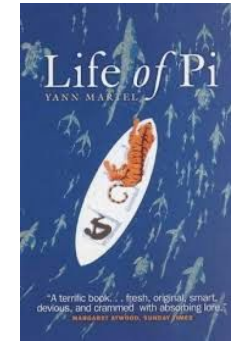


This book is a very thrilling spooky book. The book is about someone who finds a girl in a lake who appears to be alive but has been dead for about thirty years. She leads Mike, the main
